

Road Haulage CPC is for transport managers to demonstrate their professional competence in order to gain an 'O' Licence.

Applicants for a Goods Vehicle Operator's Licence must show that they are 'professionally competent' or that they employ a transport manager who meets the requirements. Persons will be considered 'professionally competent' by passing the examination for the Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC) conducted on behalf of the Department for Transport (DfT).

A gold-plated programme

The National Logistics Academy Road Haulage CPC course has been specially developed to give learners the knowledge and support to pass the examinations and achieve the OCR qualification.

Learners will develop their knowledge of road haulage laws, finance and road safety, helping to ensure a safe practice.

Employers will be complying with the Goods Vehicle Operators' Regulations 1997, as well as improving the professionalism and performance of their business.

Refresher training

We also offer a 2-day Transport Management Refresher course for CPC qualified managers who need to brush up their skills and knowledge or prove to the Traffic Commissioners they have had recent training.

National delivery

This Road Haulage CPC programme is delivered at centres throughout the UK by members of The National Logistics Academy.



Key features:

Examinations:

OCR Part 1: Multiple choice exam - 2 hours

The on-line e-exam can be arranged anytime with as little as 1 week notice. It comprises 60 questions with a pass mark of 42 and results are instantaneous.

OCR Part 2: Case study exam - 2 hours 15 mins

A paper exam held four times a year March, June, September and December, with 6 to 8 questions, a top score of 60 marks and a pass mark of 30. Results are approx. 8 to 10 weeks after the exam.
